#### **European Academic Network of Biomedical Sciences**



The EANBMS (European Academic Network of Biomedical Sciences) is a network of universities, colleges and schools that teach Biomedical Science across Europe.

The EANBMS was founded in 2011 by the EPBS, European Association for Professions in Biomedical Science, and it is right now about to be built up. In the meantime all Biomedical Science educational institutions in Europe were contacted to become members of the EANBMS.

An EANBMS member will have access to relevant information on Biomedical Science, the opportunity to participate in European projects, develop new bachelor, master and PhD programs in Biomedical Science.

The educational institutions can enhance their ERASMUS exchange programs by finding new partnerships, in the near future the web site of EPBS will have a dedicated area for the EANBMS where their contacts will appear and also a reserved area for working projects under EANBMS.

Membership is free of any charges and the educational institution is as member of the EANMBS further an affiliate member of EPBS with all the benefits associated.

  - Didn't answer
  - Didn't want to give an interview
- Contact persons?
- National Organisations were helpful
- Educational Institutions appreciated, that students contacted them and collected interviews


#### BEST WAY TO GET INTERVIEWS

- Not use term 'interview' (sounds too long)
  - Rather: few questions
- Email (addressed to a concrete person):
  - most concrete answers
- Phone:
  - Only very general answers/superficial
  - Useful as reminder for email, that was sent out before
- Face to face:
  - Very detailed too much information.
  - Difficult to find out the message
  - Takes a lot of time (and ev. travel expenses)
  - More personal and emotional
- Translation into native language






# Have you heard about EANBMS before?

#### INTEREST IN BECOMING A MEMBER

- Raise status of Biomedical Scientist among Europe
- Enhance student exchange programs
- Recognition and work abroad
- Academization (Germany, Switzerland) → Bachelor
- Idea transfer
- International partnerships
- Projects of students
- Shared lecturing
- Experience different cultures and visions
- Harmonisation of education

#### NO INTEREST IN BECOMING A MEMBER

- Already occupied with other Networks
- 'Membership of national organisation in EPBS is enough'
- Lack in time, money, staff to be active in the EANBMS
- More details necessary to decide if it is important
- Afraid, that it would be more effort than output to be a member
- Feeling of students: Language could be a problem

### EXPECTATIONS FROM EANBMS MEMBERS

- Find solutions in other countries for the own country
- Access to new development educational & professional
- Closer contact
- International exchanges
- Regular meetings
- Collaborations between institutions
- Validation of exchange programs ('quality seal...')
- Harmonisation of curricula in Europe (→semester abroad)
- Optimation of education
- Cooperation for (European) master program, shared PhD

### DOUBTS OF EANBMS MEMBERS

- Joined for 1 year now nothing happened: how to continue?
- More concrete image of EANBMS needed! Where to go?
- Worth the effort?
- Occupies time and resources institutions need to be focused on daily business

# VISIONS OF STUDENTS FOR EANBMS

#### HOW TO START WITH EANBMS

- Need of an organizational chart (organigram)
  - Head of EANBMS?
  - Organization structure?
- Set specific goals (regularly) and distribute tasks
- Establish a database for all documents shared
  - Share contact info and curricula
  - Student exchange possibilities
- Increase membership
- Promote activity of members
- Short progress updates (e.g. every two months)

#### COMMUNICATION

#### Between:

 Ed. Institutions, EPBS, students, national organisations, laboratories

#### About:

- Projects: thesis, research, development of the profession
- Exchange: students, teachers
- Curricula
- Masters and bachelors programs
- Experiences, teaching methods
- Shared learning opportunities

# COMMUNICATION HOW TO MANAGE?

- Email: own server (or via webpage server)
- Databases: contact details, shared documents
- Video conferences: regularly
- Meetings: only when purposeful (starter, finishing projects)
- Social networks
- Webpage
- Fix deadlines
- Progress updates regularly
- Journals

#### **FUTURE?**

- Support of EANBMS in international recognition of the profession
  - Common certificate!
  - Establish a pathway (professional/career)
  - Masters
- EANBMS magazine: thesis of graduates, annual reports, job offers to promote the scientific character of profession
- Help to improve visibility of profession

#### **SUMMARY**

- More than 40% interested in becoming a member
- Doubts of members and non member institutions:
  - Lack of resources (time, money, people,
  - Lack of details about EANBMS
  - Worth? maybe too early to decide now
- Suitable software as a necessary tool
- Specific goals and clear distribution of tasks
- Deadlines and progress reports regularly
- Motivate members to stay active!
